

## **UMUC ADJUNCT FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP STATEMENT**

### **Introduction:**

University of Maryland University College (“UMUC”) is establishing a scholarship to be called the “UMUC Adjunct Faculty Scholarship” (the “Scholarship”) to be supported with UMUC funds (the “Scholarship Pool”). The Scholarship Pool will be established in an initial amount of \$60,000 for the 2007-2008 academic year. The purpose of the Scholarship is to assist UMUC Adjunct Faculty Members to study in the UMUC-Adelphi School of Undergraduate Studies (“SUS”) or in the UMUC-Adelphi Graduate School of Management and Technology (“GSMT”). UMUC-Asia or Europe Adjunct Faculty Members may also take undergraduate courses offered by their respective division. The Scholarship will be available beginning with the Fall Semester or Term I of the 2007-2008 academic year. For the purposes of the Scholarship, the division to which an Adjunct Faculty Member belongs will be determined in accordance with UMUC practice.

### **I. Applicant Eligibility**

1.1. The Scholarship is available to all Adjunct Faculty members who have taught a minimum of 30 credit hours for UMUC as of the term preceding the term for which a Scholarship is requested.

1.2. The Scholarship is available to an Adjunct Faculty member while his/her adjunct contract is in effect and, for UMUC-Adelphi Adjunct Faculty Members, during participation status.

1.3. For the Scholarship to be awarded, the applicant must be admitted into a degree program at UMUC, enrolled in the requested course, and meet all requirements for the coursework toward which the Scholarship Funds, as defined below, will be applied. (Degree-seeking status is a requirement for the administration of Scholarship Funds; for purposes of this Scholarship, it does not mean that you necessarily intend to complete a degree.)

1.4. If an applicant is or has been a UMUC student at the time of application, to be eligible for the Scholarship, the applicant must be a student in good academic standing and meet the standards for satisfactory academic progress for financial aid recipients.

1.5. The Scholarship will not be awarded if the applicant has UMUC tuition remission available for the requested course.

### **II. Use of the Scholarship Funds**

2.1. Funds awarded under the Scholarship (“Scholarship Funds”) are limited to one course enrollment per academic year.

2.2. Scholarship Funds will be awarded in the amount of tuition and credited by UMUC toward tuition and for no other purpose, including by way of example, the UMUC technology fee. Scholarship Funds will not be disbursed directly to the student.

2.3. The Scholarship does not apply to: courses within executive programs, non-credit programs, and National Leadership Institute (“NLI”) programs

2.4. Scholarship Funds may be taxable as income under the United States or other income tax laws and regulations.

### **III. Application and Selection Process**

3.1. UMUC-Adelphi’s Office of Faculty Affairs will administer the Scholarship.

3.2. An applicant may apply for the Scholarship prior to being admitted to UMUC or to a specific undergraduate or graduate degree program. However, the Scholarship will not be awarded and Scholarship Funds will not be credited towards tuition until after the applicant has enrolled in the requested course.

3.3. An applicant may submit the application form for the Scholarship from the date registration opens for the applicable semester/term up until the first day of class for the applicant’s requested course.

3.4. Scholarship applications will be available at <http://www.umuc.edu/financialaid>.

3.5. The UMUC-Adelphi Financial Aid Office will award the Scholarship until the entire Scholarship Pool is depleted, on a first come basis.

3.6. Applicants must reapply for the Scholarship each academic year.
