Reference assistance

UMUC does not offer reference assistance in McKeldin Library. However, you can always contact a UMUC librarian 24 hours a day by e-mail (library@umuc.edu) and chat (https://www.umuc.edu/library/libask/ask_chat.cfm); during selected hours by instant messaging (<https://www.umuc.edu/library/libask/index.cfm>), text (240-346-0075) and during regular office hours (Monday–Saturday) for walk-in and phone (240-684-2020); in room 1500 at the UMUC Academic Center at Largo.

Borrowing privileges

With both a photo ID and current UMUC student ID, you may borrow books and other materials from any University System of Maryland and affiliated institutions (USMAI) library, including the UMCP libraries, or request that books in the USMAI catalog be delivered to UMCP or any other USMAI library for pick-up. All requests for articles or for books that are not available through the USMAI catalog must be made through UMUC's document delivery program (<https://illiad.umuc.edu/illiad/logon.html>).

Database access

Each USMAI library subscribes to its own collection of library databases. You may use UMCP's library databases at the public computers at the UMCP libraries. UMCP databases are not available to you remotely. For remote access to UMUC's library databases, available from any computer (including the public computers at UMCP), see <http://www.umuc.edu/library/libresources/index.cfm>

Printing and photocopying

To use UMCP photocopiers or computer printers, you must purchase a visitors' copy card from a Copy Card ATM (located in all UMCP libraries). Cards cost \$1. Photocopies are 10¢ a sheet for black-and-white prints and 50¢ a sheet for color prints. Computer printing is 10¢ a sheet for black-and-white printouts and 50¢ a sheet for color printouts. Late night study

UMUC students can request access to UMCP's Late Night Study Area by submitting an application form online at <http://www.umuc.edu/library/libservices/latenight.cfm> or at the UMUC library in the Academic Center at Largo during regular office hours. Upon approval of the application, students can elect to pick up the card at UMUC's Largo location or have the card delivered to their home address. Late night study cards are the property of UMUC and must be renewed or returned within five days of the end of each session. Failure to return the card will result in a \$50 fine. You can return the card by mail or in person at the UMUC library in the Academic Center at Largo or place it in the drop box at the UMUC office in McKeldin Library (Room 6259, 6th floor). (Note: You will need to apply for a guest account during McKeldin Library hours if you want to use the public computers.)

Computer lab access

UMUC students do not have access to UMCP computer labs (e.g., WAM, OWL) but may use the public computers found in the reference area or those located throughout McKeldin Library. UMUC students, faculty and staff will need to register for a guest account to use the public computers. Present a photo ID and your UMUC ID card at the circulation desk during McKeldin Library hours to register for an account with an expiration of 180 days. (Without your UMUC ID card, your account will expire in 30 days.) Accounts will not be created during Late Night Study periods.

You will find PCs with word-processing, database, spreadsheet, and other software applications available for your use at all UMUC computer labs and in the UMUC library at Largo.

Wireless access

Wireless access is not currently available to UMUC students in the UMCP libraries. There are wireless hotspots in the UMUC Academic Center at Largo and in the Inn and Conference Center in Adelphi.
