Addendum #1 dated 01/03/2012**

1. **Question:** The vendor would like to respond to the RFP in partnership with a certified value added reseller. The vendor will still be the prime but will use a partner as a vehicle for the MD state contract and to handle ongoing billing. Can the partner respond to the RFP with the vendor's input and reference the partner's state contract information?
Response: As this is a full RFP, there is no need to utilize an existing state contract. UMUC will contract directly with the awarded vendor.
2. **Question:** Does UMUC already own and use a vulnerability scanning system? If so, are you looking to replace that system?
Response: UMUC does own a vulnerability scanning system and does not plan to replace it at this time.
3. **Question:** Please clarify the number of IP addresses to be scanned by the vulnerability management system.
Response: UMUC had approximately 4000 IP addresses.
4. **Question:** For the vendor interview/discussion session: Would UMUC be available to attend this session as part of a SOC visit at the MSSP's facility?
Response: The interview/discussion sessions are optional at this time. UMUC is not interested in having a presentation at the vendor's SOC as part of this evaluation process.
5. **Question:** Regarding appendix D (Contract forms), our legal team cannot accept contractual terms during a response to a request for proposal. However, if we are selected as a finalist, we will work with UMUC on mutually agreeable terms and conditions. Is this acceptable to UMUC?
Response: Please indicate any exceptions to the contract terms in your technical response. Depending on the exceptions taken, a firm could be considered non-responsive.
6. **Question:** Regarding section 5.8 Payment. Can you clarify the subject of billing in arrears? Is UMUC expecting payments to be annually or monthly?
Response: The State of Maryland will only pay valid invoices submitted to them. Their terms are net 30. Invoice submission will be part of the negotiation process and could be monthly, quarterly or annually.
